Internship Summary

GRI is looking to recruit **two interns** interested in sustainability reporting. The main tasks will be to provide administrative support for the maintenance and continued improvement of the GRI Standards Report Registration System. Organizations use this system to inform GRI that they have used the GRI Standards in their sustainability reporting and enables this report to be published on GRI's online report repository. The position is available for a minimum period of 6 months on a full-time basis with a possibility of extension of 3 months.

If the intern is in the process of completing an undergraduate or postgraduate dissertation in the field of sustainability/ CSR they may be able to utilize the internship position to assist with their studies.

Other tasks

- Assist in coordinating improvement projects in the GRI Standards Report Registration System and related processes
- Assisting with research projects to analyze data in sustainability reports
- Support the Standards team with other administrative tasks

Key competencies/ requirements

- Personal traits such as accuracy, thoroughness and attention to detail are of the greatest importance
- Minimum advanced level fluency in written and spoken English
- Good working knowledge of Microsoft Office software
- Knowledge/interest in sustainability/CSR would be an advantage
- Ability to work in an international and multi-cultural setting
- Results-focused ability to handle multiple tasks and work on precise timelines
- Good team player with a “can do” attitude
